his issue marks the eleventh summer of Heavy Metal. Throughout our history, we have had many rebirths, constantly evolving and growing in hopes of satisfying the need in all of us to escape somewhere for an hour or so. No character in recent years has drawn more attention than Druuna (summer 1986 and spring 1988). Her adventures, her lush appeal, her story have inspired hundreds of letters and calls, some shocked, most pleased, all loud and clear

It was because of Druuna, this Mata Hari of the apocalyptic set, that the spring issue of Heavy Metal was stopped and confiscated at the Canadian border. We were in violation of code 9956, to be exact—a writ denying the importation of material dealing with sex with violence, bondage, and a whole heap of other nastiness. A dozen or so panels would have to be deleted, we were told, if we had any hope in hell of selling this issue to our neighbors to the north. Suffice it to say that pens were ordered, and we censored 36,000 copies. The writer's cramp still hasn't completely disap-

We will not try to weasel out of this. We are not going to deny that there was "sex with violence. bondage, and other nastiness" in Druuna. There was. But there is a side of this strip that seems to have been ignored. Beyond the breasts, beyond the sex, there is an extraordinary power within the story—the horror of a world gone mad. We were not condoning the violence, simply presenting a frightening, oftentimes exaggerated look into a future even more violent than the times we live in.

We here at Heavy Metal have almost always shied away from anything political. After all, this is a fantasy magazine, intended to entertain, not educate. But when we saw a Spanish version of the illustrated Universal Declaration of Human Rights, we couldn't deny the beauty or importance of such a work. We have chosen five of these short strips to run in this issue. The artists, Will Eisner, Milo Manara, Alberto Breccia, Palacios, and Juan Gimenez, are all comic geniuses revered throughout the world.

We are constantly asked where one can buy the video of Heavy Metal: The Film. You can't. It's not available. At the time the movie was made, the film company. Columbia Pictures, didn't obtain the rights to the music. It has been a long, arduous endeavor, but we are working on it, and hopefully we'll have some good news about a possible video in the future

with sickly rainbows trembled between the yellow pickets...The circular fence folded in on itself, like the two sections of a bear trap coming together—and I was caught between them. It happened quickly, with a flood of sensation bevond pain, an outbouring of sheer loss, as the teeth in that great mouth tore the front of my body away, torso and genitals, and my insides fizzed out, and it drank them down. With them went my physical sensations, my sense of inward self. All that remained was sight and hearing and objective observation. In consequence, there was no discomfort as the great pink clamps of the fingers crumpled me with a sound of squealing plastic and let me fall... falling through space...till I struck the white road, and bounced to my place beside the others: the other crumpled, inert, empty people, lying on the sidewalk beside the mounds of dog shit, unable to move, trying forever to read each other's labels.
