
Maiipoor Chronicles

came into the world in April 1948 at the Glossop Terrace Maternity Home in Cardiff, South Wales. I seem to remember spending more of my time as a small child drawing than not. The man next door, who went by the unlikely name of Peed, kept me furnished with vast heaps of paper. Repeated on each and every sheet (as I dimly recall) was the schematic layout of a ship's hold. I presume they were something to do with cargo manifests, or the like, down at Cardiff docks where Peed worked. But my chief interest was in the beautiful, blank, white reverse sides of these sheets. This free and seemingly infinite supply of paper probably played a more important part in my developing interest in art than I am consciously aware.

Whilst I retained this great interest in drawing right through my school years, and my art teacher more than once suggested that I should make it a career, there was something else in my life that pushed all other considerations aside-namely my overwhelming fascination with aeroplanes and the urgent desire to fly them. That's why I spent eighteen months from 1966 to 1968 in the RAF as a trainee pilot. I soloed on Chipmunks and Jet Provosts but, despite my attempts at hoodwinking flying instructors into believing I was the reincarnation of von Richthofen, there was ultimately no disguising the fact that I was a lousy pilot. I was perhaps even crummier where those mysterious "officer qualities" were concerned. I had two options: switch to some other non-flying training or get the hell out. I got the hell out.

It was probably a very wise idea. In September 1968, after a successful application based on a few wretched scribbles retrieved from a dusty drawer in my old school's art department, plus a couple of embarrassingly pretentious new efforts, I started my Foundation Course at Newport School of Art. South Wales. A year there was followed by a threeyear Graphic Design/Illustration course at St. Martin's School of Art in London. I think I would sum up my time there as "low profile." There was not a great deal of sympathy for my approach to things. Looking now at some of those early colored-pencil renderings, I can empathize a little with the tutors. These pictures, with an exception or two, are awful. But John Spencer must have seen some potential

there. He had recently established an illustration agency (Young Artists) and was looking around for some "talent." On the basis of a less than wonderful piece of work he had seen on some art editor's desk, he came along to my Diploma show and I was up and away. At the same time the college awarded me the most marginal of passes!

The years between 1975 and 1980 were spent exclusively on work for British publishers. Increasingly this inclined toward science fiction/fantasy material until, by 1980, I was doing very little outside the genre. One or two more "erotic" pieces were completed for Men Only magazine. This period saw me moving from watercolor to gouache to oils. By 1980 all my work was in oils. A stillborn project of this period was a television adaptation of the 1800s, of which I had been as avid a fan as any. In fact I blame Frank Hampson and Frank Bellamy (two of the greatest comic artists of all time for my early immersion in science fiction. I produced a couple of large extraterrestrial landscapes against which the action was to have taken place, but the whole thing foundered. Lack of money, I suppose.

The most interesting project of this whole period was a collaboration with Harry Harrison on an illustrated novella to be published by the now defunct Pierrot Publishing, called *Planet Story*. I spent two years producing about thirty large oil paintings for this venture, and the opportunities presented to me by this project saw my work improve by leaps and bounds.

In 1980 I was approached by Ridley Scott, the film director, to assist in a project. The portrait of Colonel Kylling from *Planet Story* had impressed Scott. He had seen in the character a dead ringer for Baron Vladimir von Harkönnen from the Frank Herbert Dane cycle, and at that time it appeared likely that Scott would direct the film version. However, the Dane curse struck again, and in the event, the film I found myself involved in was Blade Runner. This meant ten very interesting and exciting weeks in Hollywood and changeover at the end of this time from oils to acrylics.

The 1980s have seen more and more of my commissions coming from the States. My agent's establishing of a New York office has been important in this regard. In particular I regard my involvement with Bantam to have been singularly fruiful. A series of Robert Silverberg novels with my illustrations and unusually tasteful lettering was very well received, and this collaboration continues to this day. Also through the early 1980s I became involved in a couple of projects with Sir Clive Sinclair. A series of computer software packaging illustrations led to some early design work on his ill-fated C5 electric thingy [automobile]. Very different for me and extremely interesting.

A later project for Byron Preiss Visual Publications was a collaborative venture with Frank Herbert called $Ey_{\mathcal{G}}$, a collection of his short stories accompanied by some new black-and-white illustrations—the first I had done apart from one or two for the excellent Interzone magazine. Unfortunately Frank died before I met him. $Ey_{\mathcal{G}}$ must have been one of his last projects. 1986 saw the publication of Lighthip by Dragon's World, a collection of some of my work from the previous thirteen years. It makes a steady and welcome contribution to my bank balance, but has not yet threatened to transform wy lifestyle.

In May 1987 I moved with my wife, Sue, and daughters





Elinor, Megan, and Gwendolen from London to the more rural backdrop of Bradford on Avon in Wiltshire. Since then we have added a fourth (and final) member to our ranks. Our son Joseph was born in August 1988.

In 1987 I was delighted to be Artist Guest of Honor at the World Science Fiction Convention—Conspiracy 87—held in Brighton. There I received the Hugo Award for Best Artist, the first time it has been awarded outside the U.S.

I have an ongoing, long-term (very long-term!) project of my own—one in which I am attempting to both write and illustrate a book, the writing being little more than a framework within which to hang a number of pictures. These are more inclined to my own vision of a variety of futures than the necessarily circumscribed images I provide for other people's books. This started off as a specific project with a particular publisher, foundered, but had got sufficiently under way for me to want to carry on. Finding time is the real problem. The book-jacket work is a steady stream. In the end it is my bread and butter, and whilst it presents the occasional silly problem I still enjoy it as much as I ever did—and I would like to think that in some ways, stylistically and technically, it's still improving. I refuse to accept the existence of "plateaux of attainment"!
