A Day For Honey



MASTURBATION IS NOT A CRIME reads the dummer's shirt which basically fits the motif perfectly when it boils down to what this new hard-rocking bend is all about. Newly signed to TVT Records (who also handles the likes of Nine Inch Nalls and KMFDM) comes A Day For Honey - highly energized and powerfully forthight in intention to explode fast and furious into the industry.

Stepping out in a catholic schoolgirl jumper, thigh-high socks and her now bleached blonde hair is frontman Tracy Ryder (or maybe Lori Petty?) with a voice to strike solidly. Not passive or territorial. Tracy's contradiction in image to her potent vocals is the perfect touch to the "boy's club" seen behind her. The element of control in this uncategorized music is essential to performing flawlessly. "Anthony once cracked my head open on stage with his bass and I was bleeding! But I didn't flinch - I didn't let him know it bothered me. I was like 'You're an asshole - that really hurt!' going." She laughs upon remembering the incident.

Famous New York City nightcub, CRGB/s, booked A Day For Honey on September 3, 1998 - my opportunity to not only view their performance as a newbie fan, but also hear what they had to say over some beer and Bjork backdrop music. Jurado, Julia Pennington (All Mv Children), a non-human "android nursing interface" whose superb abilities are not to the liking of the human nursing staff, Gay Thomas-Wilson (Seinfeld), a respected psycho-surgeon from Earth and Jordan Lund (An American President), an alien surgeon who does not take kindly to humans.

Mercy Point which takes place in the year 2249 and is a month's journey from the Earth, is the first medical facility designed to treat both humans and androids. One has to be completely blind (or dumb) not to notice the technological progress that has been made from the 20th century to Mercy Point time of the 23rd century. For example, auto gurneys are used to move patients to trauma rooms. Here, rather than x-rays, doctors use scanners to see 3D computer images which float above the patient. "We want people to discuss what they saw. This show is going to bring up lots of moral and ethcial issues that run much deeper than what you would see on a typical sci-fi show."



fter a week among the WO, our team is still overwhelmed by their two gigantic space arks. Exploring just one of them is like exploring an entire planet. Indeed, each contains a microcosm of the WO home world. Different levels contain marshes, farmland, deserts and seas. The pyramids cover an area 500 km square and rise 400 km above the planet's surface.


Looking down at a WO ark from space, we see clouds, rivers, and vegetation suggestive of an Earth-like environment. Cloudy updrafts at the pyramid's edges are the structure's only visible effect on the atmosphere.

C. Parker Manning, captain of the Earth ship Garcia, described in his notes the ark's landing: "As the ark moved toward the planet, four walls rose, forming a box-like landing bay. The ark settled into it and lowered to the surface. Then the walls retracted back into the planet. The operation lasted only a few hours and didn't seem to disrupt the atmosphere at all."

We learned that the WO pyramids were built around an ancient atmospherically driven system for launching early space probes. Captain Manning's notes contain a diagram of the system (reproduced below). "It is as simple a launching mechanism as it is large," he wrote. "A 1000 meter cylindrical space craft is lowered down a tube at the center of the pyramid, compressing the air beneath it. The air above the cylinder is then removed, leaving an airless pathway to space. At launch, the cylinders are simply released from their moorings and air pressure pushes them into space. Fusion bursts power the craft thereafter."

WO records tell of a cylinder being destroyed as it entered Earth's atmosphere in the year 1908. Indeed, history records a violent explosion, presumed to be a comet, above Siberia during that year. Scientists are examining ways to confirm whether it was a WO ship or a natural event.

In the picture on the facing page, a scout craft leaves the **Garcia** to begin exploration of the planet's surface. In the background twin space arks frame the planet's icy moon. At the base of the ark on the right is a structure that we were told is a relic of an early space elevator. (TO BE CONTINUED)




