

In the mid 80's, he began to feel that phy tography needed to go beyond the accep ed parameters, so at this point he began tuse Mathematics to interpret his work. Pixe patterns, fractals etc, became for him not ing else than just numerical expressions.

By the 90's, with the mainstreaming of computers and graphic software, Gerardo saw the opportunity to define his personal style and expand his passion, blend drawing and photography in order to create his surreal landscapes out of this world.

His favorite applications are Photoshop, Illustrator and Painter. His favorite platform to launch his work is a set of Mac computers.

A few years ago during one of his exhibitions a reporter came to him with the term "Virtual Painting" He liked the definition and decided to adopt it. Gerardo considers his work part painting, and part photography, blended in his virtual darkroom "You can start developing your concept with a photograph, and draw whatever isn't in the original picture" "O'r vice versa, start with a regular sketch and complement it with a photograph."

At the present, his Virtual Paintings have seen exhibited in several countries, and has participated in different round table discusions regarding digital photography as the smerging new art form. He believes that ligital art is here not just to stay but to exsand and become a discipline on its own.

Although his works are constantly traveling, and his skills keep him on the road, his headquarters are located in Southern California, where he founded his own company Photo Expeditions 51.

REPRINT KINGS

Although I'm choosing to write here about Greg Theakston's work as a publisher of high quality reprints. I could just as easily be chronicling his work as a commercial illustrator, comic book inker

and colorist, or as the pinup historian who, in publishing his Bettie Pages and Tease

pinup fanzines, did the research that enabled the mainstream press to track down the elusive Bettie Page decades after her mysterious retirement, or even as the publishing innovator who created the "Theakstonizing" process that allowed Theakston and other publishers to reprint thousands of pages of rare, vintage comic books decades after the original artwork had been trashed, burned or otherwise scattered to the four winds. thereby allowing the average fan on the street to savor comics that previously were only available to the wealthy uber-collectors who could afford to view such pricey rarities. Theakston invented his bleaching process just before the era of digital technology made this feat possible inexpensively. Now, of course, the

comics anthologies Theakston pub-



remastered" so even he has joined the digital age. As should be evident by now,

Greg Theakston is a man of many parts and has made impressive contributions to comics scholarship and pinup art. Over the last three decades Theakston has shown himself to be a dedicated preservationist, even recoloring many of the vintage covers his "Theakstonizing" process had preserved, thereby demonstrating his own versatility.

The "Theakstonizing" process is one of the secrets at the heart of G.T's publishing empire. It's an ingenious but surprisingly simple method for converting old comic book pages from color to black and white, thereby ensuring the preservation of a black and white copy for future publication. Through this method, Theakston has saved much rare and historically important artwork by giants like Jack Kirby, Lou Fine, Steve Ditko, Alex Toth, Wally Wood, Frank Frazetta, Mort Meskin, and others. In fact, before digital decolorizing of old comics pages was even technically possible. Theakston was hired by DC Comics to use his de-colorizing process to create the first volumes of the DC Archives. Theakston was given DC's bound copies of decades-old rized products bearing her image comics (stretching back

> of DC at the dawn of the 1930s) to cut up and treat with his de-colorizing solution so that the black and white printing plates could be made for the fullcolor archival volumes. It was a task the resourceful artist approached with some trepidation, knowing as he did that he was holding irreplaceable

Theakston deserves credit for helping to ignite the current wave of "Bettie-mania," with its flood of merchandise featuring 50s



bination of tireless scholarship and shrewd detective work enabled him to chronicle Page's surprisingly brief career as a pinup and bondage model, including interviewing old boyfriends, and Paula Klaw, the sister of legendary photographer Irving Klaw, who took some of the most famous cheesecake and bondage photos of Bettie, as well as anyone else he could buttonhole in his quest to find out just what the hell happened to the beautiful Page, who disappeared suddenly right around 1958, and only re-surfaced a few years ago. Thanks to efforts of dedicated fans like Theakston, and Dave Stevens (who featured the beauteous Page as his hero's girlfriend in the comic book version of The Rocketeer.) Page is more popular than ever and is earning a nice living, thank you, from autho-

and also from a small amount of autographing for well-heeled Page afi-

Theakston began his publishing career in the 70's, putting out (sometimes unauthorized) fanzines that reprinted classic comic book artwork, wisely calculating that reprinting work by the acknowledged giants would have the widest possible appeal among knowledgeable collectors. However, I also suspect that Theakston also publishes what he

really likes. Among

his projects are many



Betty Pages (issues 3 & 4), I can attest to his conscientiousness as an editor, and his talent, vision and unstinting energy. Greg Theakston is always trying to go the extra mile, to rise above the mundane in the magazines and books he put out. And to a large extent, he's succeeded.

Among his most recent offerings are: The Lou Fine Reader, a 160-page black and white anthology reprinting page after page of comics by the incomparable Lou Fine, one of the greatest draftsmen of the Golden Age. Most of the stories in this collection feature classic Quality Comics superheroes like The Ray, The Dollman, Uncle Sam and The Black Condor and Fox Comics' The Flame, though there's also a run of non-superhero strips from the early anthology title Jumbo, Yet, whatever Fine drew, it's

The sparkling reproduction





highlights Fine's gorgeous inking and fluid anatomy, attributes that have influenced countless comic book artists from the 1930s on. Back in the day, Fine's fans included not just the young boys his work was aimed at, but also the growing army of young cartoonists who marveled at Fine's dynamic anatomy and assured storytelling skills, snapping up every comic he did as soon it appeared on the magazine rack. It's fair to say that Lou Fine was probably as influential on his fellow comic book artists as newspaper cartoonists like Alex Raymond and Hal Foster. Anyone who's seriously interested in the evolution of comic this book.

At \$25.00 for 160 pages, I wouldn't call this book cheap, but considering how rare and expensive most of the old comics containing Fine's work are it's a bargain. At any rate, I give The Lou Fine Reader my highest recommendation.

Theakston's also published some other great anthologies, too, like the three volumes of The Steve Ditko Reader, Volumes One and Two are also available on CD-Rom, so you can get 320 pages of top-quality Ditko reprints for a mere \$20.00. which is a really good deal, if you don't mind reading your comics on a computer screen. Volume Three is still in print and contains 160 pages of Steve Ditko's well-drawn and imaginative "mystery" and scifi stories from the mid-50s. The stories (many featuring narration by Charlton's Mysterious Traveler) are all from the period when the Comics Code Authority came in. so the scripts are bland and nonscary, but the real attraction here is Ditko's terrific art. The three volumes of The Steve Ditko Reader

give ample evidence of both Ditko's protean imagination long before he did Spider-Man and Dr. Strange, but also of his continued growth as an artist throughout 1954-1959, when he was doing similar types of stories for Atlas (later Marvel Comics). If you're a Ditko fan, or are eager to explore the work of this modern

comics master, I urge you to acquire any of the Ditko Readers. I guarantee that you'll be hooked, too. Of course you can't discuss Greg Theakston's publishing empire without touching on his

lack Kirby reprints. Theakston has probably put out more high-quality reprints of Kirby's work than any other publisher, including Marvel and DC. So far, he's up to the third volume of The lack Kirby Reader in addition to publishing several volumes of The Complete lack Kirby Library, Jack Kirby's Heroes and Villains, and even a set of Kirby trading cards. Volume Three of the Kirby Reader provides more book artwork, and the origins of evidence (as if anyone needed it) the superhero genre should own of Kirby's consummate draftsmanship and versatility, containing as it does almost every genre imaginable from comedy to romance to westerns to crime and horror, and even a few illustrations from the sci-fi pulps! Anybody who really loves comics will love this book. Like the other readers published by Pure Imagination, it's 160 pages long and retails for \$25.00. Theakston has also published a Wallace Wood Reader and (so far) two volumes of The Alex Toth Reader. Last year he also put out two excellent Wally Wood anthologies, including Wallace Wood's

The Zippos being produced now are virtually identical with the ones grandpa carried in WWII or your dad toted through the 'Nam, Every Zippo is virtually windproof (a quality that certainly accounts for their longevity and popularity) so you can light your cancer stick on the deck of a pitching aircraft carrier in the teeth of the fiercest gale, or while dangling from the side of Mount Everest. Best of all, all Zippos come with a lifetime guarantee. Baron von Lind was born October 31, 1937 in Duluth, Minnesota. With the exception of 18 years in the military he has devoted his life to art, perfecting his artistic skills through the years in all phases of the art profession. He

started as a young apprentice in a publishing firm in Duluth doing graphic art and advanced through the years in fields of art direction, illustrator of magazine art, designer, portrait painter, pinup art, sculptor and classical painting. He became nationally known as a wildlife, western, editorial, calendar and portrait painter. In the late 1950's and 1960's his illustrations were published in such notable calendar companies as Brown & Bigelow, Shedd-Brown and several others. He continues today to create new calendar pinups for publication.

BARON von LIND ARTIST'S STUDIO















In past years he has done portraits of famous celebrities and stars. He provided illustrations, designs and sculptures for such companies as General Mills, Pillsbury, Budweiser, Avon paperbacks, McCall magazine and Coca-Cola to name just a few. At one time he worked for Paramount Pictures, and did poster and portraits for such stars as Sophia Loren, Peter O'Toole, Yul Brynner and Clint Eastwood.

Of all the paintings he has done over the years, the most prestigious personalities include the commissioned portrait of President Ronald Reagan in 1982 and Queen Elizabeth of England in 1990. The famous President Reagan portrait which hung in the White House during his presidential term now hangs in the Reagan Museum in Simi Valley. California.

His famous painting titled "Mission 207" was dedicated on May 14, 2004 at March Air Force Base and is now permanently displayed as part of the museum's history honoring the men and aircraft of the World War II era.

Baron resides in Port St. Lucie, Florida where he continues to create classical, pinup and portrait art. "The Art of Baron von Lind, Volume One" has recently been published and features many of the artist's pinups. Baron's pinup art can be seen on several websites all over the world and their images produced on products from stickers, magnets, clocks, coasters, pillow, towels and t-shirts to key chains which are sold in stores from Moscow to England and through Ebay.
