As you probably already know, America Online has purchased the parent company of MAD Magazine, Time Warner. In the future it will be known as AOL Time Warner.


The question arises: Will MAD continue to be hard on AOL, poking fun at every phase of its operation, as it has since AOL came into being?


DATE MAIL
