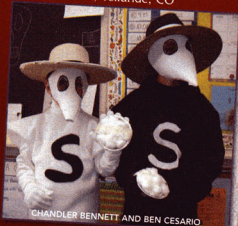

I decided to name him Mr. Muffles, a gentle name, and I took him back to live in my dorm room.

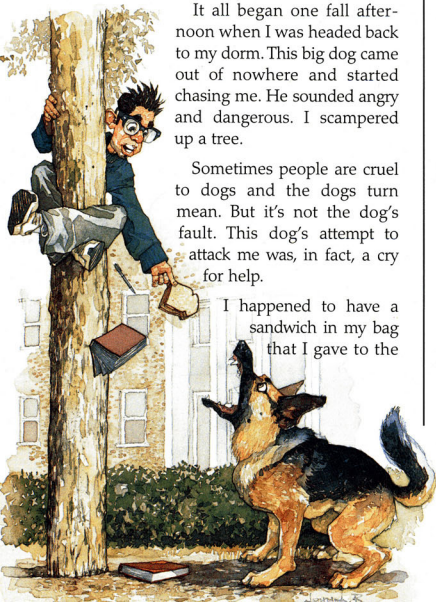
My roommate was the All-American wide receiver, Walter Washington. He was as strong as he was big and fast.

Hail, hail to you, Mr. Muffles — the dog that played football for Notre Dame and "won" everyone's love.

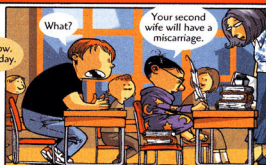
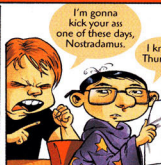
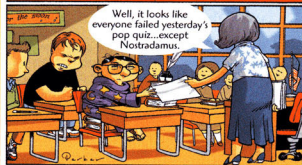
