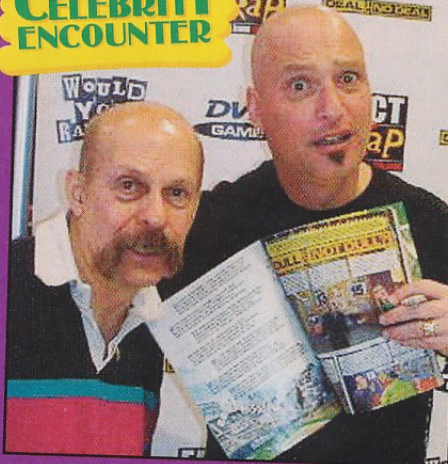

Drop what??

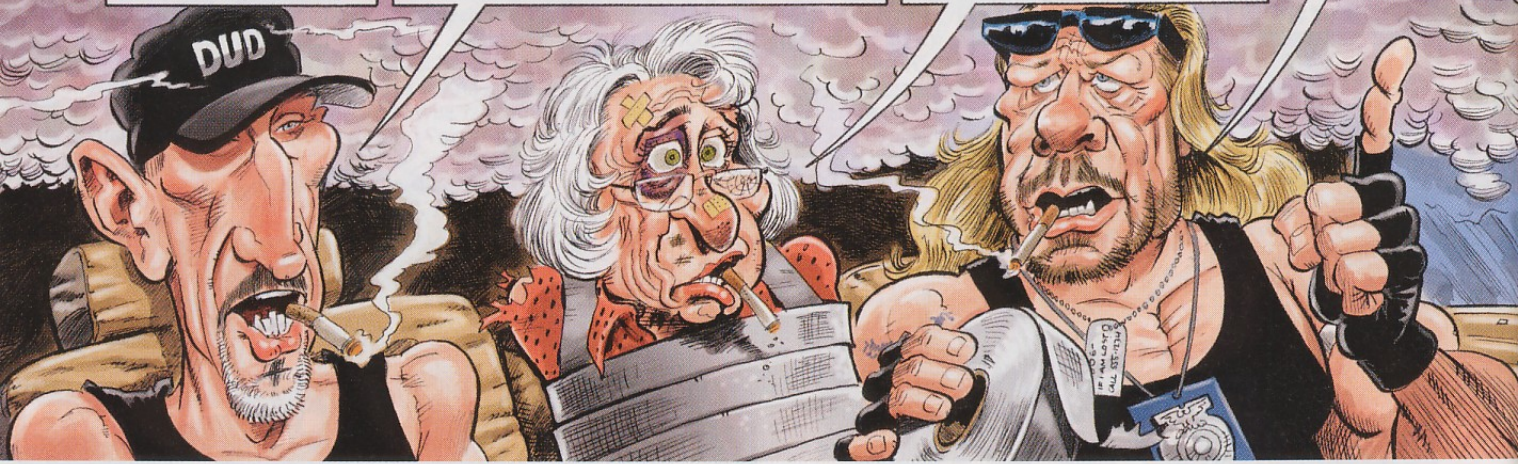
