



GRAPHIC NOVEL REVIEW

THE OPPOSABLE BABOONSBURY by Chee-Chee Trudeau Wickersham & Bros. Publishing, \$18.95

Over the years, "Baboonsbury" has gotten a reputation as a partisan screed for the liberally-inclined chimpanzee. But that's as lazy and simplistic as lumping the parvorder Platyrrhini together with the Catarrhinis, an obvious mistake no one would ever make.

Besides, the divisiveness of current politics has reenergized Chee-Chee Trudeau's

venerable strip. In recent years, it's provided some of the sharpest, most incisive ape-related satire on the comics page, And like a mother macague grooming parasites from the fur of its young. The Opposable Baboonsbury has carefully plucked the strongest storylines from the last eight years of strips.

Anyone familiar with earlier Baboonsbury compilations such as Five Little Lobbyists Jumping on the Bed and Apple Cup Drink Social Security Reform will have an idea what to expect. Longtime fans have grown up with the rotating cast of characters, from Zonka the woolly capuchin to Uncle Dookie the drug-addicted lab monkey.

For newcomers, it can be a bit much to absorb all in one gulp, the comic strip equivalent of trying to eat an entire termite colony in one meal. Don't be nervous, though, Start reading, and in no time at all, they'll seem like members of your very own phylum. These days, Trudeau primarily concentrates on the writing. Most of the art chores are handed over to a hyperactive pack of

screeching pygmy marmosets. Even so, the artistic result is still a cut above most syndicated comic strips nowadays,

As always, the storylines are a mix of the political and the personal. An "alpha male" sequence in which world leaders Curious George W., Jojo Blair and Vladimir Pooty-Poot try to one-up each other by flaunting the reddest, most dominant rump pad and anus is good for a few laughs. But only the full-color Sunday sequence truly brings the analogy home.

More emotionally wrenching is the controversial series of strips featuring longtime character D.Z. A died-in-the-fur conservative and an enthusiastic supporter of the war in Iraq, D.Z. volunteers for frontline service, only to get his prehensile tail blown off. His lengthy convalescence and recuperation struck a deep chord with readers. The Opposable Baboonsbury includes five heartfelt letters written by four badly-injured army veterans and one circus chimp who suffered a catastrophic unicycle accident.

So, no matter where your political bias lies along the spectrum of animal-based comic strips there's plenty to savor in "Baboonsbury." On the aesthetic Banana Scale, it gets three and a half Chiquitas.

AN OVERDUE TRIBUTE TO SOME OF THIS NATION'S GREATEST AND MOST INSPIRATIONAL PRIMATES


GOODY WENDELL "The Mayflower Monkey"

Believed to be the slave monkey of the Duxbury Wendells, this hairy Puritan was responsible for the removal of lice from each and every passenger aboard the famed vessel. After the first winter in Plymouth, she migrated south with the Reverend Percy Drool, who's said to have purchased her for a mere tin of mutton lard.



MISS LINK

Sadly omitted from Ken Burns' documentary, this first-ever helper monkey played an integral part in the Northern victory in the Civil War. As Ape de Camp to General Grant, she planted over 1,400 banana peel mines, wreaking great havoc upon advancing Confederates. Grant's journal notes: "...a plainer girl I have not met, yet when I watch her bound about, squealing with the joy



CORKY "VITTLES" McGOON

Forced to fend for himself during the Great Depression, McGoon wandered into the quiet, Midwestern town of Breedersville, Kansas looking for work and a little companionship. As winter was approaching, he found both in the Clumbs — a local farming family who welcomed him with open arms. Her strong hands and determined spirit were her legacies - along with the lice she accidentally gave to Susan B. Anthony in the summer of 1894.

Working at Max Yasgur's farm during the historic Summer of Love, she was also an unsung hero of the Woodstock Festival there. With her slight stature and familiarity with the terrain, she helped haul dozens afflicted from bad acid to medical tents. Charles Mirklefirth, CEO of Mirklefirth & Mirklefirth recalls, "For years I didn't understand the flashbacks where I'd feel those long furry fingers clasped around my wrists, followed by an incredible sense of safety. Now I know it was Freeda dragging me to the EMTs. I never had the chance to say thank you, and I think I may have vomited on her."
