FRANCE

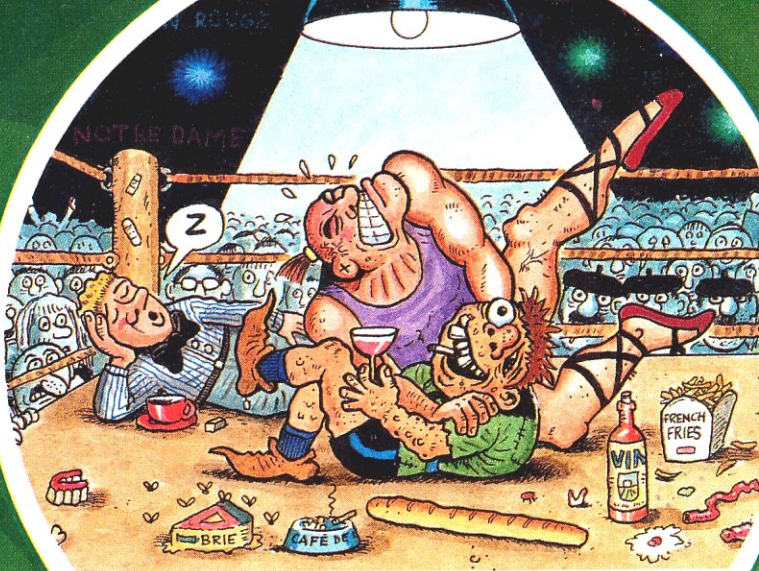
