TVTalkShows COUNTDOWN

We hear the first words from Keith Olbermann: "Which of these stories will you be talking about tomorrow?" Chances are it'll be the same ones as yesterday. Because Countdown basically only DOES one story. Republicans suck — we get it!



Time for the lead story. If there's one thing that Keith Olbermann will not stand for, it's a cheap and crooked allegation against a Democrat. Countdown schedules time for wronged officials to rebut the newest attacks and provides exhaustive fact-checking to expose the hypocrisy of the Right. Because at the end of the day, the one thing Keith WILL stand for is a cheap and crooked allegation against the G.O.P.

and if we believe what John Edwards is saving, and we have absolutely no reason NOT to, the morning he impregnated his mistress he changed his party affiliation to Republican, and went back to the Democrats the following day. As I was just saying to Tom Brokaw and David Gregory, news organizations have to end the sheeplike mentality of reporting the same thing as every other news organization. There has to be independent thinking, inquiry and analysis. And they agreed with me completely!

Andrea, is the media self-absorbed and arrogant? Tell me what you think, and I'll tell you what I think about what you think.



Next, Olbermann blasts George W. Bush for living in an echo chamber filled with yes men and ignoring outside viewpoints.
