
















FAIREY TALES



Guitar Tech Hero

If a video game series wants to remain popular, it has to adapt. Think Mario Brothers to Mario Cart, Madden '08 to Madden '09, and Burgertime to Bugertime 2: Zombie Apocalypse.

And Craptivision's massively popular Guitar Hero is no different. Unlike previous versions where gamers got to just play along to guitar classics — players can now actually TUNE the guitars that play the guitar classics in the newest game, Guitar Tech Hero!

The competition starts with the "Tune-up Showdown," where gamers can repeatedly hit up to 12 notes, including A-flat and B-minor — the foundations of many of the hard-rocking classics available on the other Guitar Hero games!

In between stages there are bonus rounds — like identifying what the hell Slash got all over his axe at last night's after-party or figuring out how to zip Lenny Kravitz into his skin-tight leather pants. It's all in a day's work for a Guitar Tech Hero!






Guitar Tech Hero offers a variety of rock reuse to tune-up in Unfortunately, wherever you pick, you only see the same two audiences — a pre-show group of disinterested sound engineers or a showtime crowd of furious, drunken concertgoers. (Their curse-filled jeers are what helped earn the game its "M for Mature" rating.)

Using the same technology as Halo, players can also go online to battle "tekkies" around the world and see who rocks sound-check the hardest! (So far there have been no takers.)
