





Aunt May should be allowed to die, and then Pete should enlist and be sent to Vietnam. His extreme money troubles would then be ended, he would be out of the clutches of Mr. Osborn/Green Goblin, and there would surely be enough somber tension arising at the battlefront for the author to allow him a full quota of human friendship in "exchange". After all, Sgt. Fury had a few human-relations problems! Perhaps Parker could meet and finally prove his worth to Flash Thompson, and I can just see the girls going into ecstasy over letters from their own private war hero. There would also be plenty of room for the Spider-Man half — fighting ordinary criminals in Saigon, Communist rings, and Far East supervillains. For example, just imagine Spidey slugging it out with the Mandarin! Frankly, since you consigned Cap to the spy-and-fantasy world of S.H.I.E.L.D., there has been a gap; comicdom has had no current war hero to rally around. 
