







The dynamic debut of the Rocket-Racer in SPIDER-MAN has provoked considerable commentary on the part of contingents both pro and con. In short, the response has been anything but indifferent. To wit, a random sampling of representative soliloquies...

Dear Marvel Madmen,

SPIDER-MAN #172 was a lot better than issue #171 (of course, I never did like team-up stories). The Rocket-Racer seemed like an interesting character, but he wasn't given much of a debut, so I hope we'll be seeing more of him soon. The Molten Man makes a good villain for Spider-Man to fight—but it gets monotonous having the Molten Man looking for chemicals to save himself, every time he appears!






STAN LEE'S SOAPBOX
