Bullpen Bulletins

I GOT THIS LETTER ...

a while back. It's from Herb Trimpe who's been a top Marvel artist since Tutankhamon wore diapers. High-fiyin' Herb pilots his very own plane—a nifty-looking open-cockpit biplane—around the country in his spare time, by the way. Here's his letter...

I thought you might get a bang out of this. We went to the beach (Delaware shore) for vacation this summer. 
