# BULLPEN BULLETINS

About ten years ago, a lawyer friend of mine told me that I could sue DC Comics for a million dollars or more. The lawyer, a lady who'd worked in the comics business for many years, had discovered that I'd started writing professionally for DC Comics in 1965 when I was thirteen years old, and had written many dozens of stories for DC's topselling titles while I was between the ages of thirteen and eighteen. Because I was a minor, she said, the legal agreements that I'd signed granting DC ownership of the stories I'd written and the characters I'd created (two of which were featured in their own series) were meaningless. She told me that I owned those stories, and would be entitled to all the income DC had received from licensing them for publication worldwide, or statutory copyright damages, whichever was greater. She said the case was airtight, and urged me to pursue it.

I never even considered it for a moment.

You see, I'd been offered the same deal as everybody else in comics in those days, and, minor or not, I'd understood it perfectly. Moreover, I'd agreed to it enthusiasticallythrilled to have the chance to write comics, and very glad to be paid what I was paid, because my family needed that money.

It wouldn't be right to go back on the deal.

X-MEN #214-The aftermath of the Mutant

Recently, a reporter from Phoenix asked me, "Do you think your comics provide good role models for your younger readers?" That's a pretty standard question, and I gave it the standard answer—that providing good role models is not our goal. We don't try to preach morals or values-business, we feel, best left to parents and educators. We're entertainers. Our business is telling good

He seemed happy with that answer, and the interview moved on. Since then, however, I've given that subject more thought. The fact is that a good story must leave the reader with something more than he started with-a thought, an idea, an insight ... What thoughts, ideas and insights were conveyed to me when I was a reader?

The Amazing Spider-Man was my favorite title back then. I identified with Peter Parker, because he and his Aunt May had money troubles just like my family did. Often his need was desperate, and he was faced with a choice between doing the self-serving, expedient thing and doing the right thing. He wasn't a paragon. Once or twice he slipped. Hey, he was only human. But, you know, I could tell that he learned from his mistakes, and in the end, when it counted. he always chose to do the right thing.

My lawyer friend's name came up in conversation the other day, reminding me of my choice not to sue DC. It occurred to me then that Peter Parker wouldn't have done it
