





Dear Jim,

"Dock Savage," in ASM #303, was another step toward making this book a really good super hero comic. It used to be a case of Spidey going from issue to issue and villain to villain with a quick rendezvous with a girffriend thrown in and a quick peck on the cheek for Aunt May in between her heart attacks. No real progression was made, and the rest of the cast were merely decorations. But now every character in the book is as real and vital as Peter himself, he's a man who's married to a woman who loves him, he's finally getting somewhere with his life. MJ knows of his dual identity so he no longer has to bear that burden by himself. And every issue of the comic is one I eagerly anticipate.

Joining forces with Sandman and the Silver Sable was a logical step for Spidey, as well as a lucrative one -- it's about time he made some money out of his powers; there's no harm in that. And the old excuse of not being able to cash a check was neatly and simply made irrelevant. I was also happy to see that the trio made short work of their overpowered quarry, and especially enjoyed Sable's "Dirty Harry" threat to Kraus. I was a little worried to see the force Spidey used against some of the lackeys-slamming two of them together in mid-air at high speed is a potentially fatal move, as is dropping them from height. It makes good comic book action but is

a little unrealistic for a man with a no-kill policy.

Peter's conversations with Mary Jane were lovely, really well written. They look like young newlyweds in love which is what they are, and MJ has never looked lovelier or sexier, which I'm sure is as Todd and Dave intend. Todd's art has brought an added dimension to the book, complementing Dave's progressive writing, and he's certainly Marvel's best artist now. The opening splash of Spidey against the moon was similar to some of the shots in Hulk, and carried equal weight and impression, and the same is true of the stunning picture of MJ as she suggests retiring to her husband. That moody final page shows that he can draw every type of scene. If this quality keeps up when the book goes bi-weekly, we're in for a glorious few months! Take care

Well, that went quick! AMAZING SPIDER-MAN #303 really brought a speedy resolution to what could have developed into the most serious crisis yet of the Parker-Watson marriage. And I'm not even disappointed by the way this was achieved. Here's why

Both Pete and MJ did not make their choices easily. Both had real doubts as to whether they were doing the right thing, and both had conscious or subconscious reasons for deciding the other way Peter with his feelings that he didn't make an adequate contribution to the family finance and Mary Jane very much aware of her mother and sister's lot. Madeline and Gayle Watson's decisions to put their own aspirations second, and the sad consequences thereof must be quite vivid in MJ's mind, and as she already had a taste of the big time, she knew what she was risking if she moved to Kansas.

All in all, I'm quite pleased with how quickly and smoothly that ticklish situation was defused and that you did not decide to milk it to excess. After all, that Peter decided to stay in the Apple did not really come as a surprise -- Spidey belongs to New York, and I just can't visualize a new adventure set in Emporia, Kansas every week (for one thing, there's no way Spidey could maintain his secret I.D. after

moving to a small town)

So I'm very happy with the way things turned out, with Pete and MJ very much in love with each other and committed to make their marriage work. They (and, of course, the Spider-writers and artists) prove that a smoothly working relationship does not have to be boring, so let's keep their marriage a happy one! Of course it helps that they are maybe Marvel's sexiest and funniest couple (MJ has a great sense of humor, which obviously helps when you're married to a super hero, and that has also helped to lighten Peter up considerably in private).

Special mention again for Todd McFarlane -- Spidey's muscles don't look that over-developed anymore (in fact, next to the Sandman, Spider-Man looked downright puny), and MJ looks just great. Keep up the good work and stay with the title! And I might add that David Michelinie's writing on Spider-Man is some of his best yet. (Oh, yes -- belated thanks for the temporary return of Spidey's German suit! It was fun while it lasted.)




