Mary Jane's inspired "announcement" of Spider-Man's entrance at the charity gala demonstrates how advantageous it is having a wife who knows your secret identity. Before this, Spidey would indeed have been sunk and had his secret I.D. at risk. Thanks to

Mary Jane, he had the perfect alibi.

The Fox is a classy villain, or at least he tries to be, not unlike the Grey Fox of the film of that name. His one aim is to lead the good life: he has no cosmic and unrealistic thoughts of world domination. Unfortunately, the Prowler (and I wonder which face is behind the mask this time) has other ideas, and I fear tragedy may be in store. 
was a little below standards.


