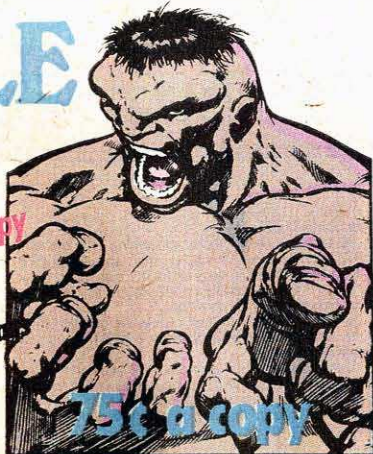
McFarlane has done this more than once and we don't want him to do it anymore. Please stop, do what you do best, Todd—full comics, not just covers.

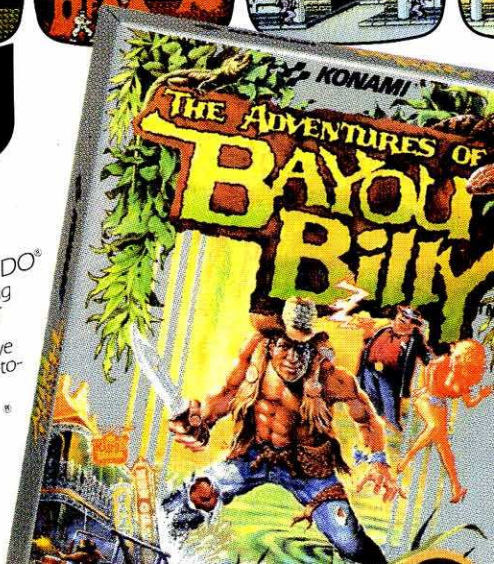
