Dear Mighty Marvel Web-Slingers,

I am an avid comic collector, and have been collecting the Spidey titles for a few years now. Boy, has this run of AMAZING SPIDER-MAN (ISSUES #320-344) been impressive. I have seen action, as much suspense as a comic can give, character development, and Spidey beatin' up a lot of bad guys, too! I'd like to volice my humble obinion on a few topics, however:

1) La Tarantula usually has one boot spike filled with knockout potion (chloral hydrate?), and one filled with a deadly substance, as seen in issue #341. Sooo, in issue #343 when the Black Cat uses his boot spikes to combat two of the Femme Fatales, does one of them die? Or does their superpowered metabolism save them? Maybe La Tarantula left both spikes full of chloral hydrate? I don't know, lyust read the book.

2) Venom. I thought it was a bold move to kill off a truly horrifying baddie like him, but now it seems you've lost your nerve. Death is a part of the real world, and it should occasionally be part of the comic world, too. 
