



That includes the giant, moosey wall chart showing how each of the characters gets to where, when and how. That includes the long phone calls and faxes from Marvel in NYC to each of the writers [John Francis Moore, San Francisco; Pat Mills and Tony Skinner, England; Peter David, Romania: don't ask) to get everybody to agree to the events on the wall chart. Not to mention my assistant, Matt Morra, continually reminding me of the correct spelling of "Krystalin.


So why do it? 'Cause it gives us the opportunity to do some really fun things. We got five, no make that, six new villains. We got a brand new locale in the 2099 universe, the floating city of Valhalla, that turns into a battleground almost as soon as it's built. And we've got the chance to bring all the 2099 characters to meet each other for the first time!

That was the especially cool part for Matt and myself: getting to see the artists' renditions of characters they don't normally draw. Rick Leonardi did a dramatically different take on the Punisher 2099, and Tom Morgan did a wild and wooly Ravage! Both Grant Miehm and Ron Lim got a chance to draw the whole gang, so we'll see their interpretations of everybody from Doom to the X-Men!

In other words, we do it 'cause it's fun for us. And if we're having a good time, chances are you'll enjoy yourself, too.

his holiday season, there are so many great TV specials on, it's tougher than ever to get out to do your holiday shopping. After all, which would you rather do - wait in line for hours in a crowded department store, or spend the evening relaxing by a fireplace with Billy Ray Cyrus's Achy Breaky Christmas Special?

Well, now, through the miracle of television, it is possible to do all your holiday shopping without ever leaving your living room! That's right, we're talking about that mega-convenient home shopping channel called QVC (Quality Viewer's Choice!). In recent months, QVC has been offering a cornucopia of comic book merchandise!

Whenever QVC has comics to pitch. they usually like to have a Marveloid doing the pitching! Among the Marvel superstars who've answered QVC's Quest for Video Champions are Peter (INCREDIBLE HULK) David, Scott (X-MEN) Lobdell, and Fabian (pretty much every other Marvel title) Nicieza. These three gents did their best to sell a variety of products, including our Quite Vivid Comics!

Peter David, who went on QVC primarily to promote his Spock-erific Star Trek novel, Imzadi, says his impressions of his home shopping debut are "a little hazy, since I was on from one to three in the morning," but overall he found it a "smartly

run, tightly knit organization. Peter finds it amusing that QVC sometimes promotes a product as a limited edition — since, as he notes, "everything in the world is a limited edition! Nothing is infinite!" (Except for the number of titles we can spin off from the X-MEN, of course.)

X-MEN writer Scott Lobdell's only TV experience prior to appearing on QVC was as an audience member of the Phil Donahue Show. Scott said that he was "inspired by Phil" to try the small-screen himself. First Scott phoned in some ques-tions during a Stan Lee QVC appearance, and then followed that up with a live-starring stint of his own on an all-X-MEN QVC extravaganza this past October. Scott's TV debut came on a Monday night, which, as Scott pointed out, meant "I had to slug it out with Murphy

Brown, but I was ready for her!"

Scott sees QVC as a launching pad for future screen projects. "I plan to star in the QVC movie," Scott said. "It'll be me and Clint Eastwood trying to sell my CAP-TAIN ULTRA Limited Series. It'll be called,

'In the Line to Get Fired!"

Scott's fellow mutant writer, Fabian Nicieza, also put in some time in the QVC Studios this past August. Fabes says a QVC appearance is "a good way to promote ourselves and promote our product. We get to reach a new audience." Fabe compares a QVC appearance to the Oprah Winfrey Show in reverse: "I like to say that Oprah is a talk show with commercials in between. We're commercials with a talk show in between!"

Fabe turned his appearance into a Marvel infomercial, with a behind-the-scenes look at how comics are created, phone calls from home viewers, and previews of upcoming X-MEN stuff. Marveloids on QVC usually promote the latest issue of whichever comic they're working on, and they can move anywhere from two to five thousand autographed copies in a two hour show.

So if you're looking for an alternative to fighting holiday traffic, unruly shoppers, and snooty store clerks, you may want to consider doing some of your gift-buying at home this year. Operators are standing by!


