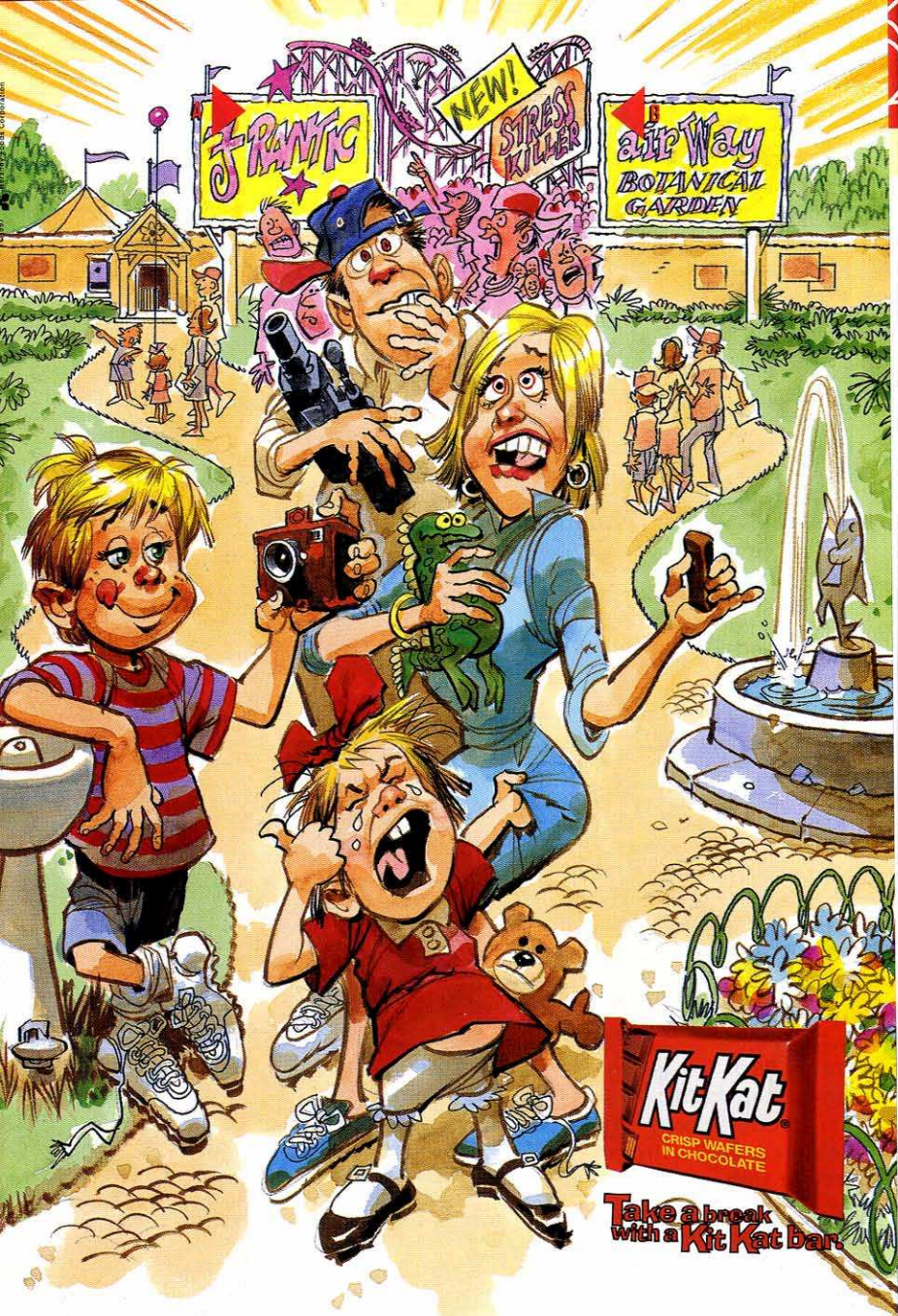
Despite the bounty on his head, SpiderMan went in search of Carnage and engaged him in battle until the unexpected arrival of the Silver Surfer.
