At first, I was going to let this pass by. Then I decided, "What the heck, I'll get this and the preceding issue and read all of "Perfect World" in one sitting, because that's the only way I'll get a handle on this wacky plot."

Turns out, this was absolutely necessary. I for one was not prepared for a revamped, upgraded Mysterio. (I don't read DAREDEVIL, so I had no idea he'd been over there and that Kevin Smith had done the upgrading, Bravo.) So this guy kidnaps Peter, Mary Jane, Aunt May, Flash, et al., and puts them in some bizarre VR lantasyland attuned to Flash's brainwaves, wherein Flash is the big hero, Spidey's the sidekick, and everyone else wants to form a fan club for Flash. This much we understood: Flash had never completely gotten over his hero-worship of Spidey, but wished he was as much "the man" in people's eyes as he was the "Big Man on Campus" in school. Mysterio preyed upon this, but what's with Mysterio's obsession with unmasking the webhead? This is new, and it's not something that comes out of that opening storyline over in WEBSPINNERS, or at least I don't think it does.

What bugs me majorly is the restration of Flash as a bully-type who has no use for Peter or anyone else, and this is after he and Peter had been friends for years. This is easily explained away as the result of Flash being shocked back to reality so abruptly after living in that fantasy world. What apparently has happened is that some deep-rooted jealousy between Peter and Flash no ver Mary Jame has come to the surface, and Flash has had trouble dealing with this. The VR only made things worse.

It hasn't been a year since the elanch, and already we've seen Sandman go back to being a villain and we've seen the apparent dissolution of a long-running friendship. Venom is on the horizon, and we already know he's reverted to his "evil" ways. What's next? Putting Black Cat back on the wrong side of the law? I hope not. Pelicia Hardy is to Spider-Man what Catwoman is to Batman. Nuff said there. Scorpion's in the on-deck circle, and he too has been upgraded in terms of power, but the jury's out on him. Doctor Octopus has been dealt with, most recently over in SPIDER-WOMAN, and Kingpin lurks in the shadows. What about the Vulture? Chameleon? Hammerhead?

I second Brendan Walsh's comment about MJ meeting up with Millie the Model. It's been, what, nearly 30 years since we last saw Millie? I think she's waaag voerdue. Considering that John and Scott have done an excellent job with MJ from the jump, one would think Millie and Chilli would be a bonus.

However, I do think the way Byrne has been dropping us into the middle of a new story straight after the last cliffhanger has led to a rather disjointed read, particular when the series is collected for the inevitable trade paperback.

I have always enjoyed Byrne's pencils but have usually found hie art to be a little too sketchy when he inks hither his better that the links of Scott Hanna. I was struck this issue by the resemblance to J. Scott Campbell's artwork, particularly the panels featuring Mary Jane and Gwen Stacy (no bad thing). Of course, it doesn't hurt that your guys can actually get a book out on scheduler.

I really enjoyed the last two-parter, but then I've always been a sucker for alternate universe stories, even though that was not actually the case. It was nice to see the reference to Mysterio's recent activities in DAREDEVIL, and it makes sense that his illusions should become more realistic, what with today's current CGI wonders.

Keep up the good work; as with most of Marvel's current output featuring the classic heroes, if the stories and art continue to be this enjoyable, you will have a long-term reader.


